Awards: Premier Award- Best performance on A route. Awards for top 10% in each class (min 5 riders). Grades as per Wessex Centre listing . Riders may select a route outside their class on a non award basis

Venue: Washing Pool Farm, East Horrington, Wells Somerset . Event entirely on private land, with number of laps decided on day.

Time: 10.30am start

Course: There will be a Primary route for Grade A riders, a combination route for Grade A/B, a secondary route for Grade B riders and a third route for Grade C . The course will be marked with flags, tape etc but the onus of finding the way rests with the rider and no protest will be entertained in this respect. Any rider who rides outside the course, causing nuisance or disturbance will be disqualified.

Entries: On the standard entry form to the Secretary of the meeting, one hour before the event. Numbers will be issued on the day

Fee: Entry fee £13 includes day membership of the club if appropriate.

ENTRY DECLARATION: I, the undersigned, apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof:-

- 1. I hereby declare that I have had the opportunity to read, and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU standing regulations, such supplementary regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.

5. I confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine described below shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Act, or equivalent legislation, and that it will comply with the regulations in respect thereof.
6. I understand and agree that I am required to register my arrival by signing on at the designated place, not less than 30 minutes prior to the commencement of my practice or first competition, whichever occurs first.

Acknowledgement of the risk of motor sport: I understand that by taking part in this event I am exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.
